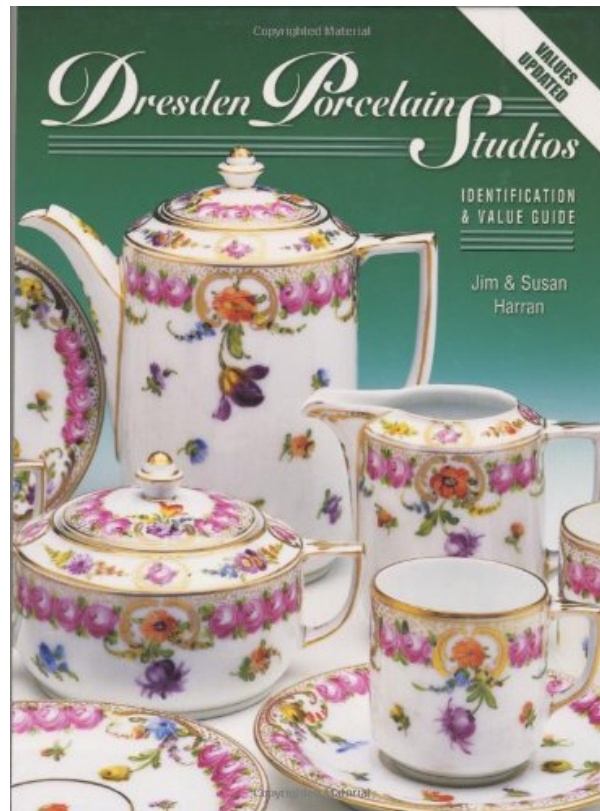
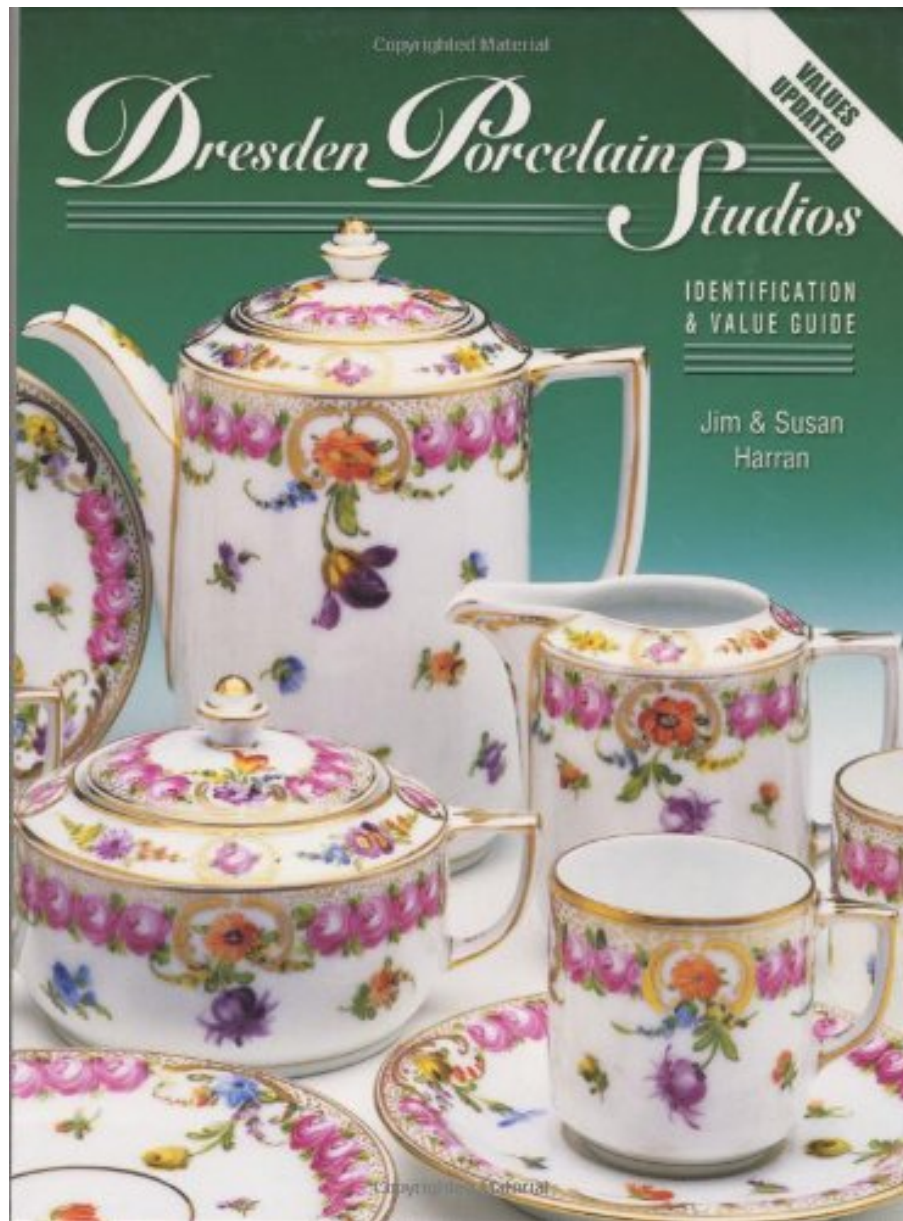

This book is the first I have found completely dedicated to authentic German Dresden porcelain tableware & figurines. I collect the figurines, and though only about 40 pages are devoted to these delicate collectibles, many of the various company marks are shown, as well as over 100 mostly color photos of the lovely unique figurines, mainly ballerinas and baroque era nobility. The bulk of the book is beautiful color photos of mostly pre-war porcelain tableware in various patterns and shapes (including basketweave, gilding, portraiture, urns, vases, candelabras and much more), their company marks, plus their value listings as of 2002 when this book was published. You need not be a Dresden collector to love this book, which would look beautiful on any coffee table, as if you don't get one with an outer jacket, the colorful porcelain tableware pictured is printed right into both sides of the book's shiny cover, and this attractive book would entertain and impress any guest.
