

There is a massively wide selection of information in here, from proper toilet sizing information on each floor, to quick schematics of lighting schemes (natural and artificial) to proper sizing of parking spots. The information is well organized and easily accessible as a desk reference. Alternately, instead of using it as a quick reference, the book can be approached front to back for a full

sketch of a building design. First address which building codes are applicable, then design the structure, bring light in from outside, then services, accessibility, parking, and area and height constraints. Not sure I'd ever come at a project or idea with such a blank slate, but it does make a sensible design strategy.
